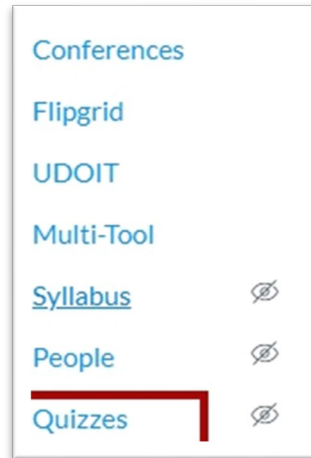


Extending Quiz Time in Canvas

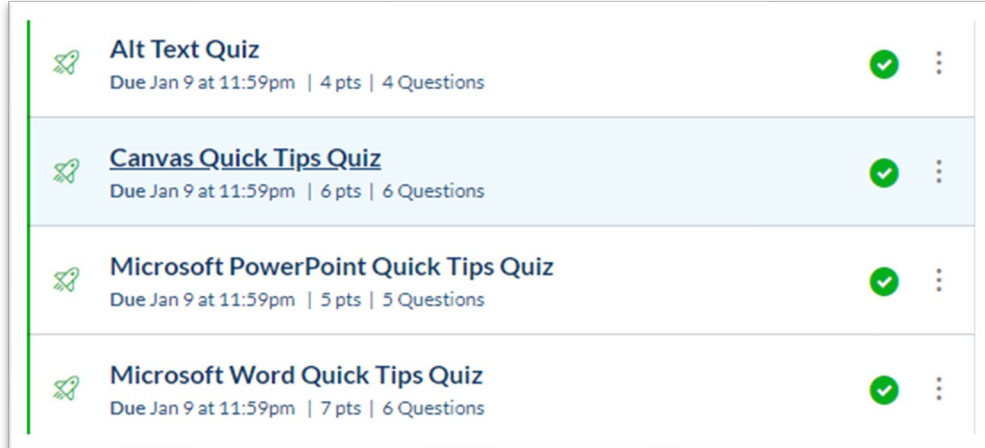
If you utilize timed quizzes in Canvas, you may need to provide additional time for students with mandated DSS testing accommodations.

Classic Quizzes

1. Choose Quizzes in the Course Navigation menu.




2. Open the quiz you need to adjust.



3. Click Moderate this Quiz from the sidebar navigation.



4. To moderate a quiz, locate the student and click the Edit icon.

You can also select more than one student and click “Change Extensions for Selected Students” button.

5. Add the appropriate amount of additional time in the “Extra time on every attempt” field. (In this example, the student is approved for 2.0 times the amount of time the class receives.)

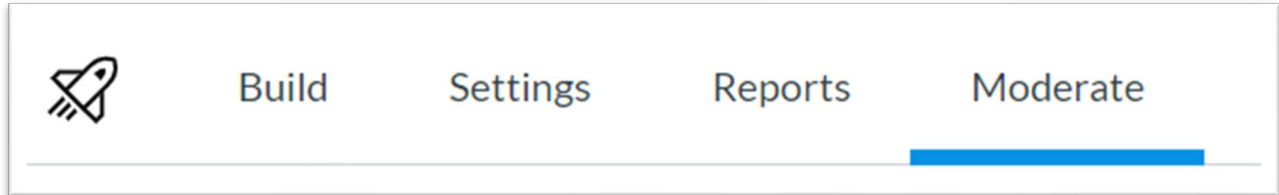
6. Verify the time extension is completed as you intended. You can also go back to the Moderate Quiz screen and see all of the students with time extensions.

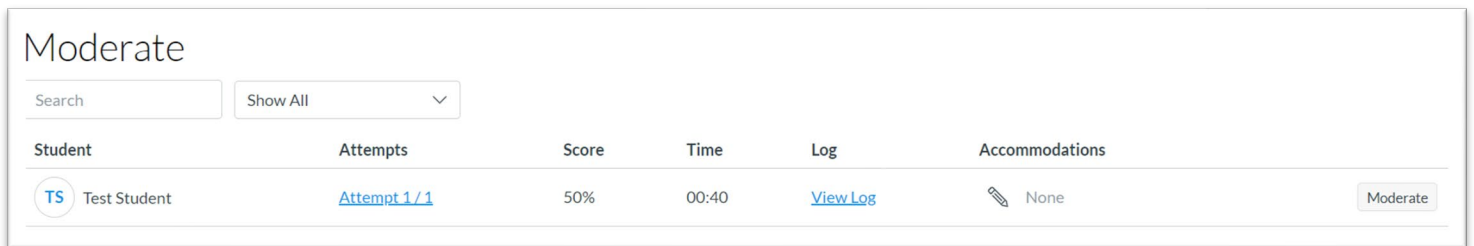
New Quizzes

If you have New Quizzes turned on in your course, the basic steps are the same as above, but the interface looks slightly different and there are some helpful accommodations enhancements that you will love.

1. Open the Quiz you need to adjust.
2. Choose Moderate from the New Quizzes menu at the top of the page.



3. Locate the student with the extended testing time accommodation and click the pencil icon under Accommodations.



4. This is where the New Quizzes enhancements make your job easier!
 - a. Note that these accommodation settings will be applied to ALL assessments for this student, so no need to moderate each quiz individually.
 - b. Select the time limit multiplier option from the drop-down menu. Then enter either 1.5 or 2.0 depending on what is listed on the student's DSS instructor letter.
 - c. Click Save.
