Integrating Publisher Resources in Canvas


If you are using a publisher website for materials, activities, and/or assessments in your course, you may be able to pair your Canvas course to the publisher course site so that students can connect to the publisher site from Canvas without having to create a separate log-in account. Some publishers also allow for deep integration (or deep linking) between your Canvas course and the publisher site, so that assignments and quizzes are individually accessible in your Canvas course and also integrated with your Canvas grade book.

Important Note: Always check to see if a publisher or resource is already paired in Canvas before trying to install yourself!

Enabling a Pre-installed Publisher in Canvas

Some publishers may already be pre-installed in Canvas.


- 1. Go to your Canvas course
- 2. Click Settings and select the Navigation tab to see which publishers are already available to enable in Canvas



- 3. You will see some publishers, like Pearson and McGraw-Hill, listed. If your publisher is listed, enable the menu item by dragging it up to the enabled navigation options or clicking the three-dot menu and clicking the Enable button.
- 4. Click the Save button at the bottom of the page to save the changes you made to the menu.

Using Publisher Materials in Assignments


1. Go to Assignments in the Course Navigation




2. Use the gold +Assignment button to create a new assignment.




3. Choose External Tool as the Submission Type



4. Click the Find button [1] or enter the External Tool URL in the URL field [2].



5. Click the name of the LTI tool [1]. Depending on the tool type, you may be taken to a separate screen for further configuration. If you want the assignment to load in a new tab, click the Load in a new tab checkbox [2]. Click the Select button [3].



6. Click either Save & Publish or Save.

Other Publishers

There are several other publishers and apps out there with varying levels of support for Canvas integration. You can Google the publisher's name and "Canvas" and "LTI" to determine if there is documentation online. You can also contact your publisher for assistance, or use the publisher's own support page to ask for information.
