- III. Canvas adapter
 - a. The new updater replaces the way Banner updates Canvas. Previously, updates were done two to four times a day.
 - b. Hopefully, soon, the new updater will be able to transfer grades from Canvas to Banner. This will be something that will require faculty to "push' the grades to Canvas. It will mean grades will not need to be manually entered in Banner. The goal for this is the end of Spring 2024.
 - c. There were questions about how this will work, but those will be answered during Spring when we test the grade updater
 - d. Highlights
 - i. Student adds are almost immediate
 - ii. Drops also within a short period of time
 - iii. Instructor updates now also happen
 - iv. Preferred name changes almost immediate
 - v. Fine-tuning so keep an eye on rosters
